### WHY IS IT A "BAD" RULE?

—THE BAD RULE—

“for every residential unit there shall be at least two off-street parking spaces provided”

1. **RIDICULOUS COST**  
(Underground parking adds avrg \$50,000 per park)

2. **POOR USE OF URBAN SPACE**  
(1/3 of new developments devoted to car parks)

3. **REDUCES TRANSPORT CHOICE**  
(creates expectation you should always own a car)

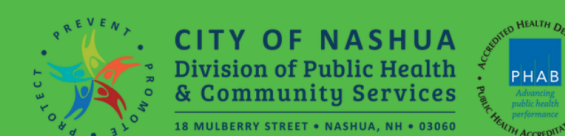
